### ASHMEAD'S KERNEL

An organically grown, dual-purpose English apple. Great for cidermaking and eating fresh, a highly acidic, sweet and crisp apple! Expect sherbert orange blossom notes followed by deep caramel and honey qualities on the finish.

### PORTER'S PERFECTION

An organically grown, old English cider apple recognized for its bright red color, thick flesh and tendency to create clusters. It's aromatic, producing bright acidic juice with mineral undertones.

### HARRISON

Known as the "survivor" due to its near extinction during prohibition. Harrison yields colossal amounts of small yellowish apples and has been in Tieton's story from the very beginning in our 3-acre test block. A sprightly, well-balanced single varietal cider with notes of green apple, lemon and hint of creamy pear.

### GOLDEN RUSSET

An old American cultivar known as the "champagne of cider apples" its a late season harvest with a sweet wholesome flavor. Golden Russet produces juice dark straw in color with notes of spiced apple, honey and a hint of ginger on the finish.
